CIRCULAR

References have been made to the undersigned as to how the Subjects of Vacant Posts are to be allotted in the Vacancies in Roster of a Particular College. To understand the problem referred, let us imagine that there are 4 Vacancies in the Roster of Asst. Prof. for 1. Assamese, 2 Economics 3. Physics 4 History. Now the question referred is how to earmark the Roster Points to the Subjects stated above when the 4 Vacancies in the Roster are dedicated to UR/SC/OBC/STH (as per roster points)

Solutions have been offered to the effect that the colleges should go in for entering the subjects alphabetically in the vacancies. This aspect is necessary to be answered properly as each of our vacancies is dedicated to one subject. There are two aspects in the vacancy of Asst. Professor that is (a). Post and (b). Subject which is not to be found in other departments where all posts in a cadre are homogenous.

Having examined the aspect properly it is thought best option to earmark the vacant posts to Subjects or Department in the manner in which the vacancies occurred in point of time. This is illustrated as under:-

Roster of the college

Roster Point No.

8 Vacant SC

9 Vacant UR

15 Vacant STP

The vacancies occurred as under.

1. Economics vacancy occurred on 5.4.2001

2. Geography vacancy occurred on 1.6.2002

3. Physics vacancy occurred on 1.8.2003

Now the Roster Point No. 8, 9, 15 has to be dedicated to subject as follows.

Roster Point 8 = Economics Roster Point No. 9 = Geography and Roster Point no. 15 = Physics in the principle that the vacancies dedicated to roster points in order in which the vacancies occurred in point of time to make our Roster most transparent and fair.

Colleges to follow accordingly.


