Sir,

In enclosing herewith the Govt. Notification No. AHE.489/2013/Pt/77, Dtd.11-06-2016, I would like to request you not to take fees including admission fees, tuition fees and all other fees from the students who will take admission in the current year in HS 1st year and TDC 1st year, provided the income of their parents from all sources is below or Rs. 1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) per annum subject to the terms and conditions as laid down in the Govt. Notification mentioned above.

Further, you are also requested to submit detailed account of the revenue loss for providing such free admission to your college to the undersigned for taking necessary action for reimbursement of the loss amount by Govt. However, you are requested not to include the revenue due to Govt. from tuition/admission fees in the detailed account for reimbursement of the revenue loss to your institution.

**ORDERS BY THE GOVERNOR
NOTIFICATION**

Dated Dispur, the 11th June/2016

No.AHE.489/2013/Pt./77 : Government of Assam in the Higher Education Department has decided that henceforth no provincialized and government colleges of Assam will take fees including admission fees, tuition fees and all other fees from the students who will take admission in the current year in HS 1st year and TDC 1st year provided income of their parents is below or Rs.1.00 lakhs (Rupees one lakh) only per annum from all sources, subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. The Principals will take certificate regarding income of parents as follows :-
 - a) If the parents work either in State or Central Government then their monthly salary slip will have to be produced while taking admission in colleges.
 - b) If they are working in private organization then the salary slip from employer indicating that their salary is not above Rs.1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) only.
 - c) If they are not working either in Government or in any private institution or organization then the certificate from the Circle Officer or Mouzadar will be considered.
 - d) In addition to the above three conditions, if the principal and the admission committee in their wisdom feel that the income of a particular student or students is below Rs.1.00 lakh (Rupees one lakh) only, then also concerned Principal can give free admission to these students.
2. After the admission procedure is over, the concerned college will give a detailed accounts of the revenue loss to the DHE for reimbursement.
3. After that, DHE will compile college-wise compensation and put up the proposal to the Government for reimbursement. The reimbursement will be complete within two months from the submission of statement by the colleges.
4. While calculating the compensation, the revenue due to the Government from tuition/ admission fees will not be included.
